Prof. Beckert has worked extensively on US elites (*The Monied Metropolis*, 2001) as well as cotton, the key commodity of the industrial revolution (*Empire of Cotton*, 2014). He has also founded the Harvard Program on the Study of Capitalism, and has explored his university's involvement in the slave trade and the slave economy (legacyofslavery.harvard.edu). He is currently finishing a new book on the history of global capitalism.
